Locomotive 6167 isn't actually magical. But it does have an interesting history! Turn to the last page to read more!



about your destination on the train car.










Who will be travelling with you? Draw a picture of you and your friends or family in the train's windows!




If your train had a whole car just for fun activities, what activities would you fill it with? Draw a picture of a train car you could have fun in!



What would you see out the window on your train journey?




What would you eat during your train journey?

Locomotive 6167



Locomotive 6167 is a steam engine. It was built in 1940, and was used by Canadian National Railways on passenger trains and freight trains.



During World War Two, Locomotive 6167 hauled troops and supplies to Canada's eastern ports.



Canadian National Railways gave Locomotive 6167 to the City of Guelph in 1967 to help celebrate Canada's 100th birthday.



In total, Locomotive 6167 travelled 2,058,238 km!
