because it got chewed on by a very excited dog in the park one day!

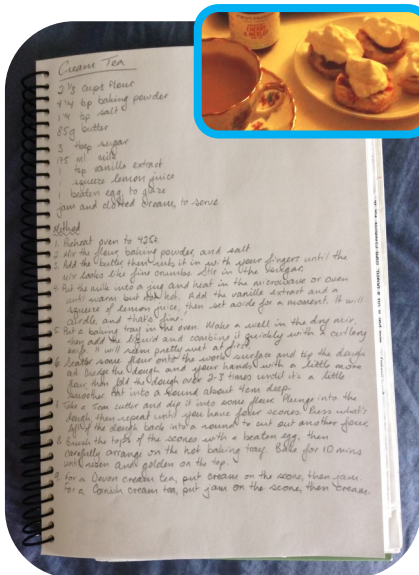

Here is my recipe for cream tea from my personal recipe book.



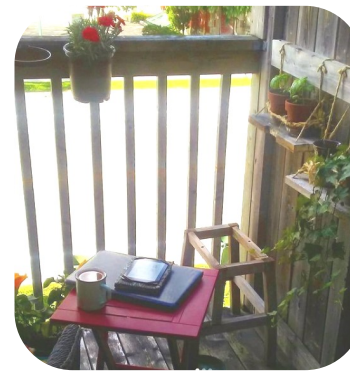
## Oral History
