

Take the Birding for Science Challenge!

Your task:

1. Choose one of these birding strategies:
 - **Outdoor hike:**
 - Choose an area to go on a hike
 - For example: U of G Arboretum, Guelph Lake, Starkey Hill, a local park, or your own neighbourhood.
 - Watch and listen for birds while on the trail!
 - **Stationary birding:**
 - Choose an area to sit/stand
 - Tip: choose an area near a bird feeder (can be at home or a public feeder at a park/trail) or near a water feature such as the Speed River for a prime birding experience!
 - Watch birds for a set amount of time (eg. 20 min).
 - Can be indoors (ie. watching from a window) or outdoors (ie. sitting at a park bench).
2. Make a list of all the birds you see, identify as many species as you can!
 - Refer to our first video all about birding for some tips and tricks!
3. Enter your list on ebird!
 - Refer to our second video for instructions on how to use ebird!
4. Repeat steps 1-3 as many times as you want!
